GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP

RULES & APPLICATION

United Bank awards up to five (5) General Scholarships in the amount of \$500 to graduating high school seniors who are customers of United Bank meeting the requirements listed below. Scholarships are paid out to recipients upon completion of one semester of post-secondary education and enrollment for a second semester.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Student is a United Bank customer
- Student is a graduating high school senior
- Student is continuing their education at a 2 or 4-year school

Please note: Separate scholarships are available for United Bank student employees and students with a parent or legal guardian employed at United Bank. Those students are not eligible for the General United Bank Scholarship and should contact United Bank directly for applications.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit all of the following to be eligible:

- Scholarship application, available on our website www.unitedbankwi.com
- Typewritten answers to items 13 & 14 on the application
- Authorization for release of information
- A copy of the student's academic transcript through the most recently completed semester of study

SUBMISSION

Completed application packet must be received no later than 5pm on Friday, **March 30th, 2018**. Applications may be submitted by mail or turned into any United Bank office, locations and addresses available on our website www.unitedbankwi.com.

SELECTION

The United Bank Scholarship Selection Committee reviews all applications. Any applications missing one or more of the required items will be disqualified.

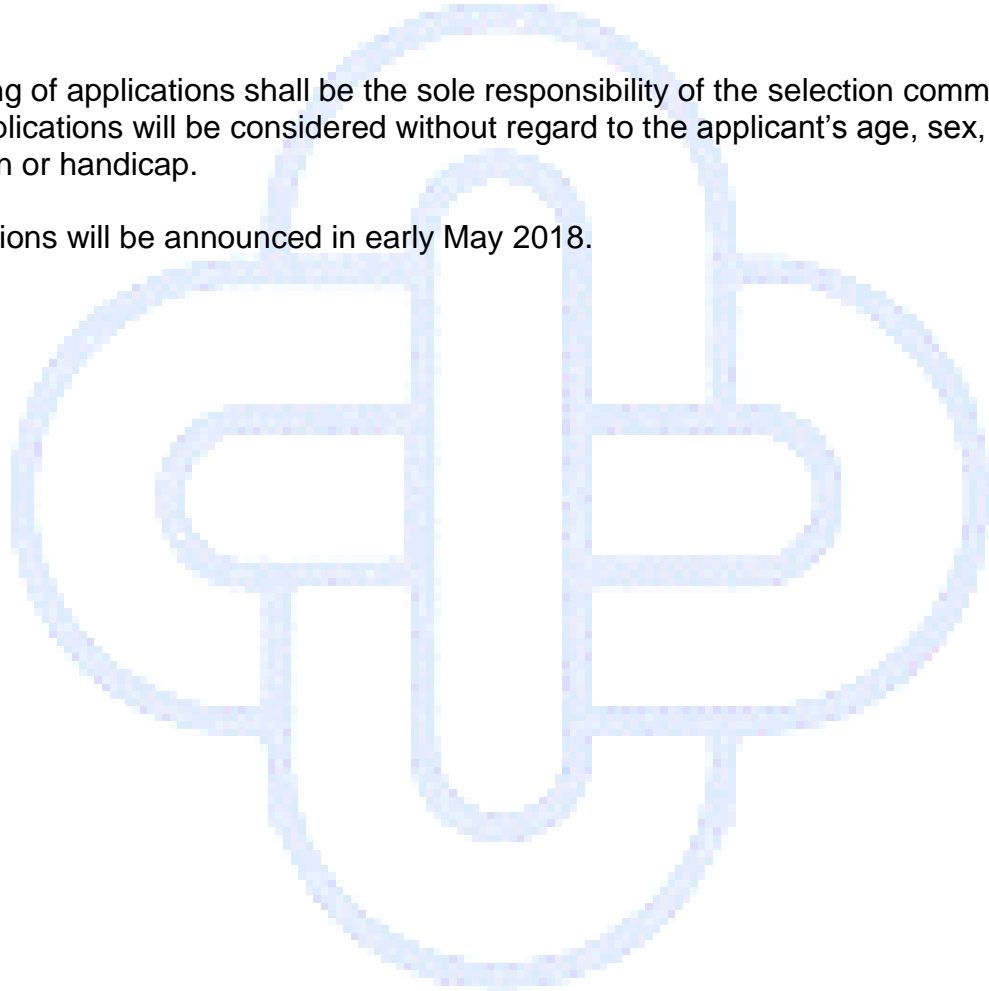
Selection will be based upon factors such as: class rank, GPA and difficulty of courses taken as well as the essay question. Preference points may be given to students entering a banking-related field.

Children of United Bank employees & United Bank work study students are not eligible for the General Scholarships and should contact United Bank's Human Resource Dept. for other applicable employee scholarships.

Scholarship will be awarded to the recipient upon completion of one semester of post-secondary education and proof of enrollment for another semester. Upon being selected for a United Bank scholarship, winners will be provided with a detailed list of instructions outlining the requirements for receiving their scholarship funds.

Judging of applications shall be the sole responsibility of the selection committee. All applications will be considered without regard to the applicant's age, sex, race, religion or handicap.

Selections will be announced in early May 2018.
